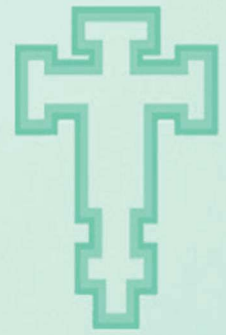

Second Collection

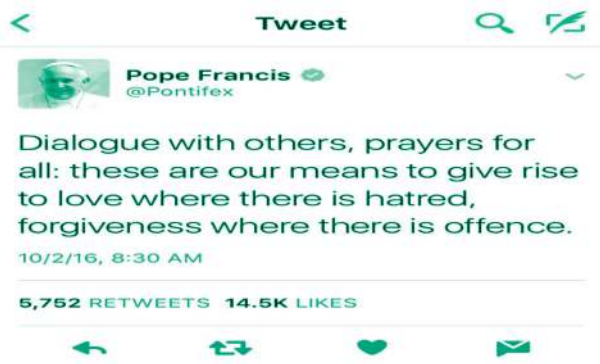
