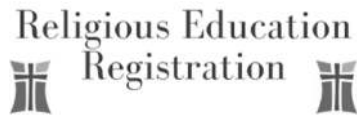

Lunch Bunch began when Fr. Art Roberts prepared a pot of soup to share with a few students from NMSU. When the group became more than a few, Lunch Bunch was formed. Our schedule follows NMSU calendar. Our meals are prepared daily. Due to the increase in food prices, we had to increase our fee to \$2.00 for students and \$4.00 for non-students. Our meals include a wholesome lunch, usually with a salad, dessert and a drink; bread is available if anyone would like to prepare a peanut butter and jelly sandwich as well. Our Lunch Bunch Coordinator, Bonnie Benedetti, plans the menus for the week and does most of the cooking. We have an outstanding crew of volunteers who clean the tables, prep work such as preparing salads, desserts and drinks. They also assist with the clean up afterwards and help do the prep work for the next day's meal. Classes are given by the Food Handlers Department for the State of New Mexico. We are always in need of volunteers. Our volunteers donate one day a week to help out, 9:30 – 1:45. Greetings Newman Community!

I trust everyone had a great Fourth of July Holiday. The Summer break is about half way done, which means Fall will be here before we know it! As we prepare to welcome and invite college students to connect and grow their faith here at NMSU Catholic Campus Ministry in the Fall Semester, I am also aware that there is a synod that is being planned which will be focused on young people. In calling for the Synod (a gathering of all the Bishops of the world in Rome), Pope Francis addressed young people:

I am pleased to announce that in October 2018 a Synod of Bishops will take place to treat the topic: "Young People, the Faith and Vocational Discernment." I wanted you to be the center of attention, because you are in my heart...I would also remind you of the words that Jesus once said to the disciples who asked him: "Teacher [...] where are you staying?" He replied, "Come and see" (Jn 1:38). Jesus looks at you and invites you to go with him. Dear young people, have you noticed this look towards you? Have you heard this voice? Have you felt this urge to undertake this journey? I am sure that, despite the noise and confusion seemingly prevalent in the world, this call continues to resonate in the depths of your heart so as to open it to joy in its fullness. This will be possible to the extent that, even with professional guides, you will learn how to undertake a journey of discernment to discover God's plan in your life. Even when the journey is uncertain and you fall, God, rich in mercy, will extend his hand to pick you up.

The Synod on Young People, The Faith, and Vocational Discernment will focus on ages 16-29. The Vatican recently released an online questionnaire that I encourage the youth of our parish, ages 16-29 to fill out. The questionnaire offers the opportunity to have your voice heard by our Bishops as they prayerfully prepare for the Synod.
